### Minutes of the Meeting of Bredfield Parish Council held at the Village Hall on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025

#### **1/300625 Apologies and approvals of absence**

Apologies had been received from Cllr's Bestow, Buckman and Henderson which were all approved.

Cllr Hepper had received a letter from Elsom Spettigue Associates, agent's for Robin D'Arcy, concerning the Forge requesting a meeting to discuss the site following dismissal of the Appeal. Cllr Hepper had also made contact directly with Mr D'Arcy who requested that any discussions take place directly with his agent. Cllr Hepper had contacted ESC Neighbourhood Plan support to obtain advice regarding The Forge following the Appeal decision. It was suggested that the meeting should include a representative from the NP review group as well as the parish council.

County Cllr Bryce had been on a prolonged period of sickness leave and cover for her role had been sporadic, however now that she had returned she had chased clarification on the footpath issue in Pump Close.

County Cllr Bryce wanted to gauge the PC's views on a Northern A12 bypass as this had reared its head again. We had mixed feelings but would watch out for further correspondence on the subject.
